I would like to say thank you to the parents who gave us their time at the Parents - Teachers meeting. I enjoyed a lot talking about everyone of my students' efforts in class.

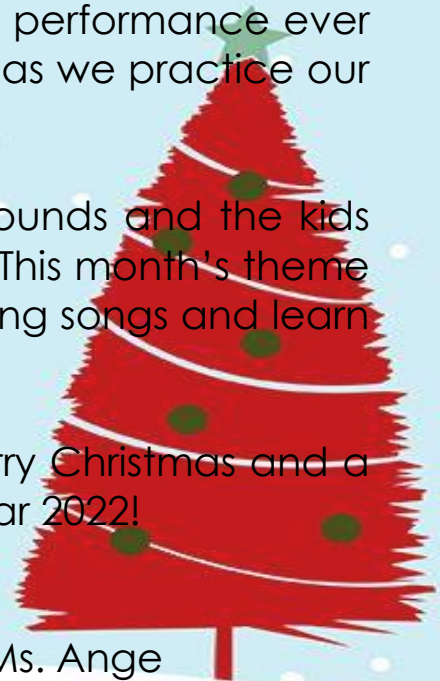
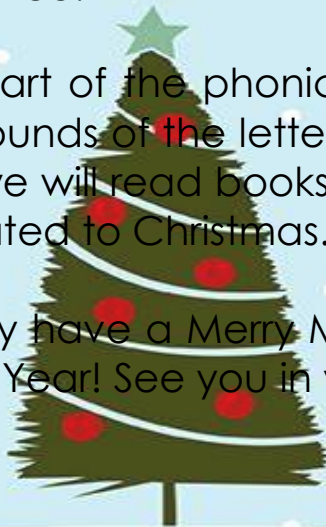
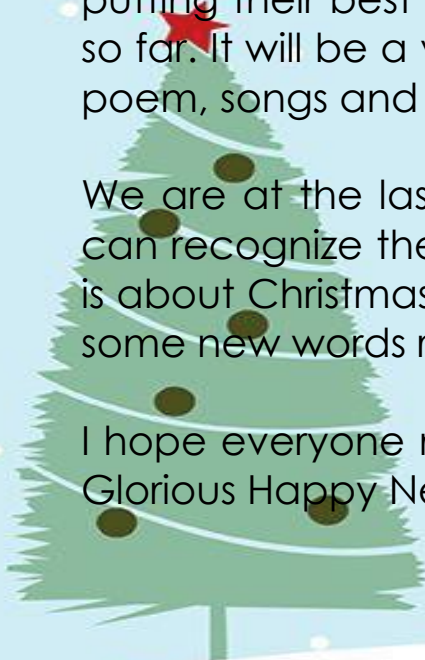
I can't believe that it's almost the last month of the year! Time flies so fast and it seems like the year has gone by so quickly as I see my student's growth everyday.
